REDEMPTION HOUSE MINISTRIES VOLUNTEER POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

In order to work well with the staff and to present the Redemption House Ministries in the best possible light, we ask that you adhere to the following policies and procedures while you are on duty as a volunteer. Failure to comply may result in disciplinary action or termination.

Qualifications:

Volunteers must be at least 15 years of age to work without parental supervision, and must enjoy working with all types of people. They must show a genuine concern for the organization. A willingness to work hard, get dirty, and pitch in wherever needed. The ideal volunteer is self-motivated, mature, sensitive, dependable, a team player and reliable.

Requirements:

Volunteers must complete a basic orientation session as scheduled before reporting to their first assignment. Additional training may also be required.

Volunteers must agree to represent the Redemption House Ministries, perform in a professional manner whenever doing so, and not to allow personal views and opinions from clouding (overshadowing) or conflicting with the Redemption House Ministries' purpose.

You will be required to fill out an application and background check.

Time commitment and scheduling:

We ask each of our volunteers to sign up for as many hours as commitments permit. A minimum (average) of two hours of service per week is requested, but not required. Volunteer hours are flexible. Our volunteers are welcome to come in for the times we schedule for them or upon request for filling in needs that become available.

Once you have agreed to be available for a particular shift, we count on you to be there. In the event you are unable to be at your shift, please call the volunteer coordinator at 541-362-5642.

Signing in:

You must sign in each time you come to work and sign out each time you finish your shift on our volunteer time sheets. Volunteer feedback:
